Mr. FRANK of Massachusetts introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To amend title 28, United States Code, to modify the residency requirement for United States attorneys and assistant United States attorneys.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 That section 545(a) of title 28, United States Code, is
4 amended to read as follows:

5 “(a) Each United States attorney shall reside in the
6 district for which he or she is appointed, except that the
7 United States attorney of the District of Columbia, the
8 Southern District of New York, or the Eastern District
9 of New York may reside within 50 miles of the district
10 for which he or she is appointed. Each assistant United

1 States attorney shall reside in the district for which he
2 or she is appointed or within 50 miles of the district. The
3 provisions of this subsection shall not apply to any United
4 States attorney or assistant United States attorney ap-
5 pointed for the Northern Mariana Islands who at the same
6 time is serving in the same capacity in another district.”.
