Mr. SMITH of Iowa introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Agriculture

A BILL

To amend the Poultry Products Inspection Act to reestablish minimum inspection and processing standards.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the Poultry and Poultry Products Inspection Act,
4 chapter 10 of title 21, United States Code, is hereby
5 amended to add a new section as follows:
6 *“All poultry and poultry products slaughtered or*
7 *processed pursuant to the provisions of this Act shall be*
8 *slaughtered and processed under standards which would*
9 *have complied with the rules and regulations and all in-*
10 *spection and reinspection standards in effect July 1, 1977.*

1 Any further change in such requirements shall not be ef-
2 fective until or unless specifically approved in a Public
3 Law.”.
