## A BILL

To amend the Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985 to provide special look-back treatment for emergency appropriations, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. REPEAL OF EMERGENCY RULE.**

4       Section 251(b)(2)(D) of the Balanced Budget and  
5       Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985 is repealed.

6       **SEC. 2. SPECIAL LOOK-BACK TREATMENT FOR EMERGENCY**  
7       **APPROPRIATIONS.**

8       Section 251(a)(5) of the Balanced Budget and Emer-  
9       gency Deficit Control Act of 1985 is amended by inserting

1 “(A)” before “If” and by adding at the end the following  
2 new subparagraph:

3 “(B) If an appropriation that the President  
4 designates as emergency requirements and the Con-  
5 gress so designates in statute is enacted for the fis-  
6 cal year in progress and that causes a breach within  
7 a category for that year (after taking into account  
8 any sequestration of amounts within that category),  
9 the discretionary spending limits for the next fiscal  
10 year shall be reduced by the amount or amounts of  
11 that breach.”.
