Mr. BACHUS of Alabama (for himself, Mr. DORNAN, and Mr. FRANKS of Connecticut) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Government Operations

A BILL

To require that certain Government consumer information publications that are distributed without charge include a statement that they are financed by the taxpayers of the United States.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. STATEMENT REQUIRED FOR CERTAIN GOVERN-**
4 **MENT PUBLICATIONS.**

5 Any consumer information publication that—

6 (1) is prepared by a department, agency, or
7 other entity of the executive branch of the Govern-
8 ment; and

1 (2) is distributed without charge;
2 shall contain a statement, prominently displayed on the
3 cover or first page, as follows: “The printing and distribu-
4 tion of this publication is financed by the taxpayers of the
5 United States”.

6 **SEC. 2. DEFINITION.**

7 As used in this Act, the term “consumer information
8 publication” means a publication distributed to the public
9 for general educational and informational purposes.
