Mr. FOGLIETTA submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the
Committee on Foreign Affairs

RESOLUTION

Concerning the December 1992 presidential election in the
Republic of Korea.

Whereas free and fair presidential elections provide the basis
for peaceful transition of power and the legitimacy of a
newly elected president;

Whereas the Republic of Korea held its first free and fair
presidential election on December 18, 1992; and

Whereas the legitimately elected President Kim Young-sam
will enjoy a strong relationship with the United States:
Now, therefore be it

1 *Resolved*, That the House of Representatives—

2 (1) applauds former President Roh Tae-Woo's

3 advocacy and administration of the free and fair

1 presidential election held on December 18, 1992, in
2 the Republic of Korea;

3 (2) recognizes such election as symbolizing the
4 commitment of the Republic of Korea to a demo-
5 cratic form of government;

6 (3) recognizes President Kim Young-sam as a
7 harbinger of democracy in the Republic of Korea;
8 and

9 (4) wishes President Kim Young-sam well in his
10 presidency.
