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## IN THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

Mr. BURTON of Indiana submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Foreign Affairs

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## RESOLUTION

To declare that July 12, 1994, be recognized as “Kashmir World Action Day”.

- 1       *Resolved*, That the House of Representatives—
- 2           (1) declares that on July 12, 1994, the world’s
- 3       news media, governmental bodies, and citizens focus
- 4       attention on the continuous abuse of human rights
- 5       perpetrated against the Kashmiri people;
- 6           (2) calls on all parties to the Kashmir dispute
- 7       to abide by international standards of human rights
- 8       and humanitarian law and cease extrajudicial
- 9       killings, torture, and other human rights violations;

1           (3) calls on the Indian government to restore  
2       due process of law and support the initiatives of  
3       independent and nongovernmental organizations in  
4       monitoring against human rights abuses; and

5           (4) calls on the governments of both India and  
6       Pakistan to recognize and respond to the call for  
7       self-determination, a right which was historically  
8       promised but never exercised by the people of Kash-  
9       mir and to reactivate the role of the United Nations  
10      as a catalyst in this process which would include full  
11      participation of the Kashmiri people.
