## A BILL

To require prior notification of the Congress of anticipated commitments of United States funds to United Nations peacekeeping activities in excess of available appropriations.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3       That the United States Permanent Representative to the  
4       United Nations shall, wherever practicable, notify the  
5       Congress in advance of any meeting of the United Nations  
6       Security Council held to decide whether to call upon the  
7       member countries of the United Nations to participate in  
8       international peacekeeping activities, if participation by

1 the United States in such activities would require an obli-  
2 gation of funds in excess of amounts made available to  
3 the United Nations for that fiscal year.
