A BILL

To provide for the income tax treatment of certain distributions under a governmental plan.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TREATMENT OF CERTAIN DISTRIBUTIONS**

4 **UNDER A GOVERNMENTAL PLAN.**

5 If—

6 (1) during calendar years 1987, 1988, 1989,
7 and 1990, distributions were made under a govern-
8 mental plan (as defined in section 414(d) of the in-
9 ternal Revenue Code of 1986) in connection with the
10 transition to a new retirement system being estab-

1 lished by the governmental entity maintaining such
2 plan,

3 (2) one or more of the employees receiving such
4 distributions erroneously treated such distributions
5 as eligible for rollover treatment under section
6 402(a)(5) of such Code, and

7 (3) with respect to such distributions received
8 in calendar years 1987, 1988, and 1989, the Inter-
9 nal Revenue Service is providing relief to employees
10 who erroneously treated such distributions as being
11 so eligible,

12 the Internal Revenue Service shall provide the same relief
13 for distributions received in calendar year 1990 as is being
14 provided for distributions received in calendar years 1987,
15 1988, and 1989.
