A BILL

To amend the Agricultural Act of 1949 to permit producers on a farm who were prevented from planting the 1993 crop of corn because of a disaster to devote conservation use acreage under the 0/92 program to soybeans, and for other purposes.

3 **SECTION 1. PREVENTED PLANTED DISASTER ASSISTANCE**
4 **FOR 1993 CROP OF FEED GRAINS.**

5 The first sentence of section 105B(c)(1)(F)(ii) of the
6 Agricultural Act of 1949 (42 U.S.C. 1444f(c)(1)(F)(ii))
7 is amended—

1 (1) by striking “crambe, and” and inserting
2 “crambe,”; and

3 (2) by inserting before the period at the end the
4 following: “and, in the case of producers on a farm
5 who are eligible for a prevented planting disaster
6 payment under paragraph (2)(A) for the 1993 crop
7 of corn, soybeans”.

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
