A BILL

To require the Commodity Credit Corporation to refund to first processors of sugarcane and sugar beets marketing assessments collected by the Corporation during fiscal year 1991, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REFUND OF SUGAR MARKETING ASSESSMENTS**

4 **COLLECTED DURING FISCAL YEAR 1991.**

5 Notwithstanding section 206(i) of the Agricultural
6 Act of 1949 (as added by section 1105(c) of the Omnibus
7 Budget Reconciliation Act of 1990 (Public Law 101-
8 508)), the Commodity Credit Corporation shall refund to

1 first processors of sugarcane and sugar beets marketing
2 assessments collected by the Corporation from the proc-
3 essors in accordance with such section 206(i) during the
4 period beginning July 1, 1991, and ending September 30,
5 1991.
