Mr. WOFFORD introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Finance

To make technical corrections to emergency unemployment benefits provisions.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

(a) IN GENERAL.—Subclauses (II) and (III) of section 102(b)(2)(A)(v) of the Emergency Unemployment Compensation Act of 1991 are amended to read as follows:

6 “(II) The requirements of this
7 subclause are met for any week if the
8 national rate of total unemployment
9 (seasonally adjusted) for each of the 2
10 most recent calendar months (not
11 averaged) for which data are pub-

1 lished before the close of such week is
2 less than 7 percent, and if the re-
3 quirements of subclause (III) are not
4 met for such week.

5 “(III) The requirements of this
6 subclause are met for any week if the
7 national rate of total unemployment
8 (seasonally adjusted) for each of the 2
9 most recent calendar months (not
10 averaged) for which data are pub-
11 lished before the close of such week is
12 less than 6.8 percent.”.

13 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
14 subsection (a) shall apply as if included in the amend-
15 ments made by section 101(b) of the Unemployment Com-
16 pensation Amendments of 1992.

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
