Mr. GRAHAM introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs

A BILL

To provide that certain service in the American Field Service ambulance corps shall be considered active duty for the purposes of all laws administered by the Secretary of Veterans Affairs.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AMERICAN FIELD SERVICE.**

4 Section 401 of the GI Bill Improvement Act of 1977
5 (38 U.S.C. 106 note) is amended—

6 (1) in subsection (b), by striking “subsection
7 (a)” each place it appears and inserting “subsections
8 (a) and (d)”;

1 (2) in subsection (c), by striking “subsection
2 (a)” and inserting “subsections (a) and (d)”; and

3 (3) by adding at the end the following new sub-
4 section:

5 “(d) Notwithstanding any other provision of law,
6 service rendered before August 15, 1945, by any person
7 who was part of the enlisted wartime personnel of the
8 American Field Service ambulance corps and who reported
9 for duty overseas during World War II, shall be considered
10 active duty for the purposes of all laws administered by
11 the Secretary of Veterans Affairs.”.
