A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on ranitidine hydrochloride (bulk and dosage forms).

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. RANITIDINE HYDROCHLORIDE.**

4 Subchapter II of chapter 99 of the Harmonized Tar-
5 iff Schedule of the United States is amended by inserting
6 in numerical sequence the following new subheading:

“	9902.31.12	N[2-[[[5- [(dimethylamino)methyl]-2- furanyl]methyl]thio]ethyl]- N'-methyl-2-nitro-1,1- ethenediamine, hydro- chloride (ranitidine hydro- chloride-bulk form, pro- vided for in subheading 2932.19.50007) (ranitidine hydrochloride-dosage form, provided for in subheading 3004.90.60)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/95	”.
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1 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

2 The amendment made by this Act shall apply with
3 respect to articles entered, or withdrawn from warehouse
4 for consumption, on or after the 15th day after the date
5 of enactment of this Act.

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
