## A BILL

To extend the temporary suspension of duty on umbrella  
frames.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. UMBRELLA FRAMES.**

4       Heading 9902.66.03 of the Harmonized Tariff  
5 Schedule of the United States is amended by striking  
6 “12/31/92” and inserting “12/31/94”.

7 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

8       (a) IN GENERAL.—The amendment made by this Act  
9 applies with respect to articles entered, or withdrawn from  
10 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after  
11 the date of the enactment of this Act.
