Mr. WOFFORD introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Governmental Affairs

A BILL

To limit the duration of payments of expenses of former Speakers of the House of Representatives.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LIMITATION ON THE DURATION OF PAYMENTS**
4 **OF EXPENSES OF FORMER SPEAKERS OF THE**
5 **HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.**

6 The period for which expenses of former Speakers of
7 the House of Representatives may be paid shall end 1 year
8 after the date of the expiration of the term of office as
9 Representative of the former Speaker involved, except
10 that, in the case of a former Speaker who is receiving such

1 expenses on the date of the enactment of this Act, the
2 period shall end 1 year after the date of the enactment
3 of this Act.

4 **SEC. 2. DEFINITION.**

5 For purposes of this Act, the term “expenses of
6 former Speakers of the House of Representatives” means
7 the office, allowance, and other expenses provided for
8 former Speakers of the House of Representatives under
9 House Resolution 1238, Ninety-first Congress, enacted
10 into permanent law by chapter VIII of the Supplemental
11 Appropriations Act, 1971 (2 U.S.C. 31b–1 et seq.).

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
