5 (a) TRI-SERVICE STANDOFF ATTACK MISSILE PRO-
6 GRAM.—Funds available for the Department of Defense
7 for fiscal year 1994 may not be expended for advance pro-
8 curement for proceeding into low-rate initial production in
9 fiscal year 1995 under the Tri-Service Standoff Attack
10 Missile (TSSAM) program.

1 (b) JAVELIN ADVANCED ANTITANK WEAPON SYS-
2 TEM PROGRAM.—Funds available for the Department of
3 Defense for fiscal year 1994 may not be expended for pro-
4 ceeding into low-rate initial production under the Javelin
5 Antitank Weapon System–Medium (AAWS–M) program
6 of the Army.
