Mr. WOFFORD introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Foreign Relations

A BILL

To limit the continued availability of foreign assistance funds for obligation and expenditure.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LIMITATION ON CONTINUED AVAILABILITY OF
4 FOREIGN ASSISTANCE FUNDS.**

5 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, amounts
6 authorized to be appropriated to the President to carry
7 out programs, projects, or activities under the Foreign As-
8 sistance Act of 1961 or the Support for East European
9 Democracy (SEED) Act of 1989 shall remain available for
10 obligation and expenditure not more than 36 months after

1 the close of the fiscal year in which the funds are appro-
2 priated.

3 **SEC. 2. WAIVER.**

4 The President is authorized to waive the application
5 of the limitation contained in section 1 if the President
6 determines that to do so would be in the national interest
7 of the United States.
