A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on diazo-2,1,4-sulfonic acid and its salts.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DIAZO-2,1,4-SULFONIC ACID AND ITS SALTS.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
7 new heading:

“	9902.31.12	Diazo-2,1,4-sulfonic acid and its salts (CAS Nos. 117-70-4 and 64173-92-6) (provided for in sub-headings 2927.00.40 and 2927.00.50)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/96	”.
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1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 this section shall apply with respect to goods entered, or
3 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
4 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
