Mr. PRESSLER introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred
to the Committee on Banking, Housing, and Urban Affairs

A BILL

To amend the Mount Rushmore Commemorative Coin Act
to conform to the intent of Congress.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DISTRIBUTION OF SURCHARGES.**

4 Section 8 of the Mount Rushmore Commemorative
5 Coin Act (31 U.S.C. 5112 note) is amended by striking
6 paragraphs (1) and (2) and inserting the following:

7 “(1) the first \$18,750,000 shall be promptly
8 paid by the Secretary to the Society to assist the So-
9 ciety’s efforts to improve, enlarge, and renovate the
10 Mount Rushmore National Memorial; and

1 “(2) the remainder shall be returned to the
2 United States Treasury for purposes of reducing the
3 national debt.”.

4 **SEC. 2. RETROACTIVE EFFECT.**

5 The amendments made by section 1 shall be deemed
6 to have the same effective date as the Mount Rushmore
7 Commemorative Coin Act. Any surcharges paid into the
8 United States Treasury prior to the date of enactment of
9 this Act in connection with the issuance of coins under
10 the Mount Rushmore Commemorative Coin Act (which
11 amounts have not been otherwise obligated) shall be redis-
12 tributed by the Secretary of the Treasury in accordance
13 with the amendments made by section 1.
