Mr. ROCKEFELLER, from the Committee on Veterans' Affairs, reported the following original bill; which was read twice and placed on the calendar

A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to permit the burial in cemeteries of the National Cemetery System of certain deceased Reservists and the dependents of such reservists.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ELIGIBILITY OF CERTAIN RESERVISTS AND DE-**
4 **PENDENTS FOR BURIAL IN NATIONAL CEME-**
5 **TERIES.**

6 (a) RESERVISTS.—Section 2402 of title 38, United
7 States Code, is amended—

1 (1) by redesignating paragraphs (5) and (6) as
2 paragraphs (6) and (7), respectively; and

3 (2) by inserting after paragraph (4) the follow-
4 ing new paragraph (5):

5 “(5) Any member or former member of the
6 Armed Forces who has performed at least 20 years
7 of service computed under section 1332 of title 10
8 under honorable conditions as determined by the
9 Secretary concerned.”.

10 (b) DEPENDENTS.—Paragraph (6) of such section,
11 as redesignated by subsection (a)(1), is amended by strik-
12 ing out “paragraphs (1) through (4)” and inserting in lieu
13 thereof “paragraphs (1) through (5)”.

14 (c) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section 2306(a)(4)
15 of such title is amended by striking out “2402(5)” and
16 inserting in lieu thereof “2402(6)”.
