A BILL

To authorize a certificate of documentation for certain
vessels.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That notwithstanding sections 12106, 12107, and 12108
4 of title 46, United States Code, and section 27 of the Mer-
5 chant Marine Act, 1920 (46 App. U.S.C. 883), as applica-
6 ble on the date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary
7 of Transportation may issue a certificate of documentation
8 for the following—

9 (1) the vessel PRINCESS XANADU OF
10 MONACO, United States official number 660847;

1 (2) the vessel INSPIRATION, United States
2 official number 277099;

3 (3) the vessel VENUS, United States official
4 number 54719;

5 (4) the vessel LATER, United States official
6 number 615732; and

7 (5) the vessel MATCH MAKER, United States
8 official number 908725.

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
