Mr. COCHRAN (for himself and Mr. LOTT) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Agriculture, Nutrition, and Forestry

A BILL

To provide disaster assistance to producers for certain losses due to freezing conditions in 1994, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DISASTER ASSISTANCE FOR CERTAIN LOSSES**
4 **DUE TO FREEZING CONDITIONS IN 1994.**

5 The matter under the heading “COMMODITY CREDIT
6 CORPORATION FUND” under the heading “COMMODITY
7 CREDIT CORPORATION” of chapter I of Public Law 103–
8 75 (107 Stat. 741) (as amended by the matter under the
9 heading “COMMODITY CREDIT CORPORATION” of chapter
10 I of Public Law 103–211) is further amended—

1 (1) by inserting after “title XXII of Public Law
2 101–624” the following: “or as otherwise determined
3 by the Secretary”; and

4 (2) by inserting before the period at the end the
5 following: “: *Provided further*, That funds made
6 available under this paragraph for the Commodity
7 Credit Corporation shall also be available for pay-
8 ments to producers for the 1994 through 1998 or-
9 chard crop losses, and 1994 forest crop, livestock,
10 and dairy losses, if the losses are due to freezing
11 conditions in 1994, except that the use of funds
12 made available under this proviso is designated by
13 Congress as an emergency requirement pursuant to
14 section 251(b)(2)(D)(i) of the Balanced Budget and
15 Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985 (2 U.S.C.
16 901(b)(2)(D)(i)) and the use shall be available only
17 to the extent the President designates the use as an
18 emergency requirement pursuant to such Act”.

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
