2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REMOVAL OF MAXIMUM INTEREST RATE LIM-**
4 **TATION ON FFB LOAN REFINANCING.**

5 Section 306C of such Act (7 U.S.C. 936c) is amend-
6 ed—

- 1 (1) in subsection (c)(2), by striking “, except
- 2 that such rate shall not be greater than 7 percent
- 3 per year, subject to subsection (d)’”; and
- 4 (2) by striking subsection (d).
