3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF PRODUCTION INCENTIVE**
4 **CERTIFICATE PROVISIONS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Additional U.S. Note 5(h)(i) to
6 chapter 91 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the
7 United States is amended by striking “January 1, 1995,”
8 and inserting “January 1, 2007,”.

1 (b) EXTENSION OF CERTIFICATE NUMBER PIC-EV-
2 89.—Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the pro-
3 duction incentive certificate, number PIC-EV-89, issued
4 jointly by the Secretary of Commerce and the Secretary
5 of the Interior to the Hampden Watch Company, Inc.,
6 pursuant to paragraph (h)(i)(B) of Additional U.S. Note
7 5 to chapter 91 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the
8 United States (formerly paragraph (h)(i)(II) of headnote
9 6 of schedule 7, part 2, subpart E of the Tariff Schedules
10 of the United States), shall be deemed to have been re-
11 issued on the date of the enactment of this Act in the
12 amount of the balance remaining on such certificate, and
13 shall expire on the date that is 1 year after such date of
14 enactment.
