To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to extend the provision relating to medicare-dependent, small rural hospitals, and for other purposes.

Mr. PRYOR (for himself, Mr. ROCKEFELLER, and Mr. BOREN) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Finance

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# A BILL

To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to extend the provision relating to medicare-dependent, small rural hospitals, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-  
2       tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. MEDICARE-DEPENDENT, SMALL RURAL HOS-  
4       PITALS.**

5       (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1886(d)(5)(G) of the So-  
6       cial Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395ww(d)(5)(G)) is amend-  
7       ed—

8               (1) by amending clause (i) to read as follows:  
9               “(i) In the case of a subsection (d) hospital which  
10       is a medicare-dependent, small rural hospital, payment

1 under paragraph (1)(A) for discharges occurring before  
2 October 1, 1994, shall be—

3           “(I) for any cost reporting period beginning on  
4           or after April 1, 1990, and before April 1, 1993, the  
5           amount determined under clause (ii); and

6           “(II) for any cost reporting period beginning on  
7           or after April 1, 1993, the amount determined under  
8           clause (ii) by substituting ‘50 percent’ for ‘100 per-  
9           cent.’.”;

10           (2) by redesignating clauses (ii) and (iii) as  
11           clauses (iii) and (iv), respectively; and

12           (3) by inserting after clause (i) the following  
13           new clause:

14           “(ii) The amount determined under this clause is the  
15           sum of—

16           “(I) the amount determined under paragraph  
17           (1)(A)(iii), and

18           “(II) 100 percent of the excess (if any) of—

19                “(aa) the hospital’s target amount for the  
20                cost reporting period, as defined in subsection  
21                (b)(3)(D), over

22                “(bb) the amount determined under para-  
23                graph (1)(A)(iii).”.

24           (b) PERMITTING HOSPITALS TO DECLINE RECLASSI-  
25           FICATION.—If any hospital fails to qualify as a medicare-

1 dependent, small rural hospital under section  
2 1886(d)(5)(G)(i) of the Social Security Act as a result of  
3 a decision by the Medicare Geographic Classification Re-  
4 view Board under section 1886(d)(10) of such Act to re-  
5 classify the hospital as being located in an urban area for  
6 fiscal year 1993, the Secretary of Health and Human  
7 Services shall—

10 (2) provide an opportunity for such hospital to  
11 decline such reclassification, and

17 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
18 subsection (a) shall take effect on the date of the enact-  
19 ment of this Act.

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
