3 **SECTION 1. 2-YEAR EXTENSION OF PERIOD FOR ISSUANCE**

4 **OF MEDICARE SELECT POLICIES.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 4358(c) of the Omnibus
6 Budget Reconciliation Act of 1990 (42 U.S.C. 1320c–3
7 note) is amended by striking “3-year” and inserting “5-
8 year”.

1 (b) DEADLINE FOR EVALUATION.—Section 4358(d)
2 of such Act (42 U.S.C. 1320c–3 note) is amended by strik-
3 ing “January 1, 1995” and inserting “January 1, 1996”.

4 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

5 The amendments made by section 1 shall take effect
6 as if included in the enactment of the Omnibus Budget
7 Reconciliation Act of 1990.

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
