A BILL

To authorize the Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity to establish a memorial to Martin Luther King, Jr., in the District of Columbia.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AUTHORITY TO ESTABLISH MEMORIAL.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—

5 (1) ESTABLISHMENT.—Subject to subsection

6 (b), the Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity is authorized to

7 establish a memorial to Martin Luther King, Jr., in

8 the District of Columbia and its environs in accord-

9 ance with the Act entitled “An Act to provide stand-

10 ards for placement of commemorative works on cer-

1 tain Federal lands in the District of Columbia and
2 its environs, and for other purposes”, approved
3 November 14, 1986 (40 U.S.C. 1001 et seq.), to
4 honor Martin Luther King, Jr.

5 (2) DEFINITION.—For purposes of paragraph
6 (1), the term “the District of Columbia and its envi-
7 rons” has the same meaning given to such term by
8 section 2(e) of such Act.

9 (b) EXPENSE TO THE UNITED STATES.—The United
10 States shall not pay any expense of the establishment of
11 the memorial under subsection (a).
