3 **SECTION 1. CANTALOUPEs.**

4 Subheading 9902.08.07 of the Harmonized Tariff
5 Schedule of the United States is amended by striking out
6 “12/31/92” and inserting “12/31/94”.

7 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

8 The amendment made by the first section of this Act
9 applies with respect to goods entered, released, or with-
10 drawn for consumption after December 31, 1992.
