## A BILL

To require the Secretary of Defense and the Defense Base Closure and Realignment Commission to make recommendations in 1993 and 1995 for the termination and reduction of United States military operations at military installations outside the United States.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CLOSURE AND REALIGNMENT OF MILITARY IN-**  
4 **STALLATIONS OUTSIDE THE UNITED STATES.**

5 (a) FINDINGS.—Congress makes the following find-  
6 ings:

1           (1) It is necessary to reduce military operations  
2       by the United States at military installations located  
3       outside the United States because of the changing  
4       threat to the national security and because of budg-  
5       etary constraints.

6           (2) The number of United States military per-  
7       sonnel stationed overseas is scheduled to be reduced  
8       over the next three years.

9           (3) Congress has accepted two sets of commis-  
10      sion recommendations regarding the closure and re-  
11      alignment of military installations inside the United  
12      States and will soon consider a third set of commis-  
13      sion recommendations.

14          (4) Closures and realignments of military in-  
15      stallations inside the United States have a profound  
16      economic impact on the communities involved.

17          (5) It is essential that future recommendations  
18      by the Secretary of Defense and by the Defense  
19      Base Closure and Realignment Commission concern-  
20      ing the closure and realignment of military installa-  
21      tions include recommendations for the termination  
22      and reduction of military operations carried out by  
23      the United States at military installations located  
24      outside the United States.

1 (b) RECOMMENDATIONS REGARDING MILITARY OP-  
2 ERATIONS OUTSIDE THE UNITED STATES.—The Defense  
3 Base Closure and Realignment Act of 1990 (part A of title  
4 XXIX of Public Law 101–510; 10 U.S.C. 2687 note) is  
5 amended by adding at the end the following new section:

6 **“SEC. 2912. MILITARY INSTALLATIONS OUTSIDE THE**  
7 **UNITED STATES.**

8 “In 1993 and 1995, the Secretary and the Commis-  
9 sion shall each submit recommendations for the termi-  
10 nation and reduction of military operations carried out by  
11 the United States at installations outside the United  
12 States with the recommendations for closure and realign-  
13 ment of military installations that the Secretary and the  
14 Commission, respectively, submit under this part in those  
15 years.”.
