# A BILL

To provide that the cost of living adjustment to increase the rate of pay for Members of Congress in calendar year 1994 shall not take effect.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 SECTION 1. COST OF LIVING ADJUSTMENT FOR PAY OF  
4 MEMBERS OF CONGRESS NOT EFFECTIVE IN  
5 CALENDAR YEAR 1994.

6 Notwithstanding section 601(a)(2) of the Legislative  
7 Reorganization Act of 1946 (2 U.S.C. 31(2)), the cost of  
8 living adjustment (relating to pay for Members of Con-  
9 gress) which would become effective under such provision

1 of law during calendar year 1994 (if not for the provisions  
2 of this section) shall not take effect.
