A BILL

To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to provide coverage under such title for certain chiropractic services authorized to be performed under State law, and for other purposes.

3 **SECTION 1. COVERAGE OF CERTAIN CHIROPRACTIC SERV-**

4 **ICES AUTHORIZED TO BE PERFORMED BY**

5 **STATE LAW.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1861(r) of the Social Se-
7 curity Act (42 U.S.C. 1395x(r)) is amended in the first
8 sentence by amending clause (5) to read as follows:

1 “(5) a chiropractor who is licensed as such by
2 the State, and who meets uniform minimum stand-
3 ards promulgated by the Secretary, but only for pur-
4 poses of subsections (s)(1), (s)(2)(A), and (s)(3),
5 and only with respect to diagnostic x-rays, diagnostic
6 physical examinations, and treatment by means of
7 manual manipulation of the spine (for conditions
8 demonstrated by an x-ray or physical examination to
9 exist) which such chiropractor is legally authorized
10 to perform by the State or jurisdiction in which such
11 treatment is provided.”.

12 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
13 this section shall become effective with respect to chiro-
14 practic services performed on or after January 1, 1994.

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
