Mr. DECONCINI introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Governmental Affairs

A BILL

To reduce the rate of pay for each Member of Congress to the rate which was in effect before the cost of living adjustment in calendar year 1993.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REDUCTION OF COST OF LIVING ADJUSTMENT**
4 **FOR PAY OF MEMBERS OF CONGRESS.**

5 (a) REDUCTION OF PAY.—The rate of pay for each
6 annual rate which was increased under section 601(a)(2)
7 of the Legislative Reorganization Act of 1946 (2 U.S.C.
8 31(2)) (relating to Members of Congress) during calendar
9 year 1993, shall be reduced to the rate of pay which was
10 in effect before such increase became effective.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The provisions of this sec-
2 tion shall be effective on the first day of the first applica-
3 ble pay period beginning on or after the date of the enact-
4 ment of this Act.
