A BILL

To temporarily suspend the duty on Bendiocarb.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. BENDIOCARB.**

4 Subchapter II of chapter 99 of the Harmonized Tar-
5 iff Schedule of the United States (19 U.S.C. 3007) is
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
7 new item:

“	9902.31.12	2,2,-Dimethyl-1,3-benzodioxol-4-yl methylcarbamate (Bendiocarb) (provided for in subheading 2932.90.10)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/94	”.

1 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

2 The amendment made by this Act shall apply with
3 respect to articles entered, or withdrawn from warehouse
4 for consumption, on or after the date that is 15 days after
5 the date of enactment of this Act.
