A BILL

To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to provide for a limitation on use of claim sampling to deny claims or recover overpayments under medicare.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LIMITATION ON USE OF CLAIM SAMPLING TO
4 DENY CLAIMS OR RECOVER OVERPAYMENTS
5 UNDER MEDICARE.**

6 (a) LIMITATION ON USE OF CLAIM SAMPLING.—Sec-
7 tion 1869(a) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.
8 1395ff(a)) is amended—

4 (2) by adding at the end thereof the following
5 new paragraph:

6 “(2) Except for purposes of assessing civil money
7 penalties for fraud under section 1128A(a)—

8 “(A) the determination with respect to a claim
9 for benefits under part A or part B shall be based
10 solely on the individual’s entitlement to such bene-
11 fits; and

12 “(B) the Secretary may not make any deter-
13 mination with respect to any claim for benefits de-
14 scribed in paragraph (1) by applying information ob-
15 tained through a process of claim sampling to such
16 claim.”.

17 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—(1) Section
18 1862(f) of such Act (42 U.S.C. 1395y(f)) is amended by
19 striking “otherwise” and inserting “otherwise that meets
20 the requirements of section 1869(a)(2)”.

21 (2) Section 1869(b)(1) of such Act (42 U.S.C.
22 1395ff(b)(1)) is amended by striking “subsection (a)” and
23 inserting “subsection (a)(1)”.

1 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

2 The amendments made by section 1 shall apply to
3 determinations on claims for benefits under title XVIII of
4 the Social Security Act issued on or after the date of en-
5 actment of this Act.
