To extend the effective period of a production incentive
certificate.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF PRODUCTION INCENTIVE**
4 **CERTIFICATE.**

5 The production incentive certificate, number PIC–
6 EV–89, issued jointly by the Secretary of Commerce and
7 the Secretary of the Interior to the Hampden Watch Com-
8 pany, Inc., pursuant to paragraph (h)(i)(B) of Additional
9 U.S. Note 5 to Chapter 91 of the Harmonized Tariff
10 Schedule of the United States (19 U.S.C. 1202) (formerly
11 paragraph (h)(i)(II) of headnote 6 of schedule 7, part 2,

1 subpart E of the Tariff Schedules of the United States),
2 shall be deemed to have been reissued on November 1,
3 1993, in the amount of its balance remaining on that date,
4 and shall expire on October 31, 1994.
