# A BILL

To amend title II of the Social Security Act to repeal the rule providing for termination of disabled adult child's benefits upon marriage.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 SECTION 1. REPEAL OF RULE PROVIDING FOR TERMINATION  
4 OF DISABILITY BENEFITS FOR DISABLED ADULT CHILD  
5 FITS UPON MARRIAGE.

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 202(d) of the Social Secu-  
7 rity Act (42 U.S.C. 402(d)) is amended—

10 (2) by striking paragraph (5); and

1 (3) in paragraph (6)—

2 (A) by inserting “(other than by reason of  
3 death)” after “terminated”,

4 (B) by striking “(provided no event speci-  
5 fied in paragraph (1)(D) has occurred)”, and

6 (C) by striking “the first month in which  
7 an event specified in paragraph (1)(D) occurs”  
8 in subparagraph (C) and inserting “the month  
9 in which the child’s death occurs”.

10 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—

1        (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by  
2 this section shall apply with respect to marriages occur-  
3 ring on or after May 1, 1991.
