Mr. DURENBERGER introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Finance

A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on photoreceptors and assemblies containing photoreceptors.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PHOTORECEPTORS AND ASSEMBLIES.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.90.90 of the Har-
5 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States is amend-
6 ed—

7 (1) by striking the article description and in-
8 serting “Photoreceptors or assemblies containing
9 photoreceptors of electrostatic copying machines,
10 which machines operate by reproducing the original

1 image via an intermediate (provided for in sub-
2 heading 9009.90.00).”, and

3 (2) by striking “12/31/92” and inserting “12/
4 31/96”.

5 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
6 this section apply with respect to goods entered, or with-
7 drawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after the
8 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
