## A BILL

To suspend until January 1, 1995, the duty on Malathion.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-  
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. MALATHION.**

4       (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
7 new heading:

“	9902.31.12	0.0 Dimethyl phosphorodithioate of diethyl mercapto- succinate (Malathion) (provided for in subheading 2930.90.40) .....	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/94	”.

8       (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
9 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or

- 1 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
- 2 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
