A BILL

To extend the existing suspension of duty on methyl and ethyl parathion and dimethoate.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF EXISTING SUSPENSION OF**
4 **DUTY.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.29.89 of the Har-
6 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
7 methyl and ethyl parathion and dimethoate) is amended
8 by striking “12/31/92” and inserting “12/31/94”.

9 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
10 subsection (a) applies with respect to articles entered, or

- 1 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
- 2 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
