A BILL

3 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON USE OF FUNDS.**

4 Until such time as the Congress votes to accept or
5 reject the recommendations of the Defense Base Closure
6 and Realignment Commission that are transmitted to
7 Congress in 1993 pursuant to section 2903(e) of the De-

1 fence Base Closure and Realignment Act of 1990, funds
2 available to the Secretary of the Navy may not be obli-
3 gated or expended to relocate the functions and personnel
4 of the Mine Warfare Command, the Fleet Mine Warfare
5 School, the Mine Warfare Training Center, or any mine
6 countermeasure helicopter squadron to Ingleside, Texas.
