Mr. JOHNSTON introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Finance

A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on sethoxydim.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SETHOXYDIM.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.— Heading 9902.38.09 of the Har-
5 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States is amended
6 by striking “12/31/90” and inserting “12/31/97”.

7 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—

8 (1) IN GENERAL.—The amendment made by
9 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered,
10 or withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on
11 or after the 15th day after the date of the enact-
12 ment of this Act.

1 (2) RETROACTIVE APPLICATION TO CERTAIN
2 ENTRIES.—Notwithstanding section 514 of the Tar-
3 riff Act of 1930 (19 U.S.C. 1514) or any other provi-
4 sion of law, upon proper request filed with the ap-
5 propriate customs officer before the 90th day after
6 the date of the enactment of this Act, any entry, or
7 withdrawal from warehouse for consumption, of any
8 goods described in heading 9902.38.09 of the Har-
9 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States that
10 was made—

11 (A) after December 31, 1992; and

12 (B) before the 15th day after the date of
13 the enactment of this Act;
14 shall be liquidated or reliquidated as though such
15 entry or withdrawal occurred on the 15th day after
16 the date of the enactment of this Act.
