Mr. LAUTENBERG introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Appropriations

A BILL

To prohibit expenditure of appropriated funds on the Superconducting Super Collider, the Advanced Solid Rocket Motor, or the Space Station.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SEC. 101. TERMINATION OF THE SUPERCONDUCTING
4 SUPER COLLIDER PROGRAM.**

5 (a) PROHIBITION.—Effective 90 days after the date
6 of enactment of this section, no appropriated funds shall
7 be available for use on the Superconducting Super Collider
8 program.

1 (b) EXCEPTION.—The provisions of subsection (a)
2 shall not apply to any actions taken in terminating the
3 Superconducting Super Collider program.

4 (c) UNEXPENDED FUNDS.—Any funds appropriated
5 for use on the Superconducting Super Collider program
6 that remain unobligated and unexpended 90 days after the
7 date of enactment of this section shall be credited to the
8 general revenues of the United States Treasury.

9 **SEC. 102. TERMINATION OF THE ADVANCED SOLID ROCKET**

10 **MOTOR PROGRAM.**

11 (a) PROHIBITION.—Effective 90 days after the date
12 of enactment of this section, no appropriated funds shall
13 be available for use on the Advanced Solid Rocket Motor
14 program.

15 (b) EXCEPTION.—The provisions of subsection (a)
16 shall not apply to any actions taken in terminating the
17 Advanced Solid Rocket Motor program.

18 (c) UNEXPENDED FUNDS.—Any funds appropriated
19 for use on the Advanced Solid Rocket Motor program that
20 remain unobligated and unexpended 90 days after the date
21 of enactment of this section shall be credited to the gen-
22 eral revenues of the United States Treasury.

1 **SEC. 103. TERMINATION OF THE SPACE STATION PRO-**2 **GRAM.**

3 (a) PROHIBITION.—Effective 90 days after the date
4 of enactment of this section, no appropriated funds shall
5 be available to carry out the provisions of section 106 of
6 the National Aeronautics and Space Administration Au-
7 thorization Act of 1988 (42 U.S.C. 2451 note).

8 (b) EXCEPTION.—The provisions of subsection (a)
9 shall not apply to any actions taken in terminating the
10 United States International Space Station Freedom pro-
11 gram.

12 (c) UNEXPENDED FUNDS.—Any funds appropriated
13 for use on the United States International Space Station
14 Freedom program that remain unexpended and unobli-
15 gated 90 days after the date of enactment of this section
16 shall be credited to the general revenues of the United
17 States Treasury.
