3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF EXISTING SUSPENSION OF**
4 **DUTY ON 1-[1-((4-CHLORO-2-(TRIFLUORO-
5 METHYL)-PHENYL)IMINO)-2-PROPOXYETHYL]-
6 1-H-IMIDAZOLE.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.31.07 of the Har-
8 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States is amended
9 by—

1 (1) inserting “(triflumizole)” after “1-[1-((4-
2 Chloro-2-(trifluoromethyl)-phenyl)imino)-2-propoxy-
3 ethyl]-1-H-imidazole”; and

4 (2) striking "12/31/92" and inserting "12/31/
5 98".

6 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—

22 (A) after December 31, 1992; and

(B) before the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act:

1 shall be liquidated or reliquidated as though such
2 entry or withdrawal occurred on the 15th day after
3 the date of the enactment of this Act.
