A BILL

To extend the temporary suspension of duty on
Trifluoromethylaniline.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF DUTY SUSPENSION.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.30.33 of the Har-
5 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States is amended
6 by striking out “12/31/92” and inserting “12/31/96”.

7 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
8 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or
9 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
10 the date which is 15 days after the date of the enactment
11 of this Act.

1 (c) RELIQUIDATION.—Notwithstanding section 514
2 of the Tariff Act of 1930 or any other provision of law,
3 upon proper request filed with the appropriate customs of-
4 ficer on or before the date which is 90 days after the date
5 of the enactment of this Act, any entry of an article de-
6 scribed in heading 9902.30.33 of the Harmonized Tariff
7 Schedule of the United States that was made—
8 (1) after December 31, 1992, and
9 (2) before the date which is 15 days after the
10 date after the enactment of this Act,
11 shall be liquidated or reliquidated as though such entry
12 occurred on or after the date that is 15 days after the
13 date of the enactment of this Act.
