A BILL

To require certain payments made to victims of Nazi persecution to be disregarded in determining eligibility for and the amount of benefits or services based on need, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN PAYMENTS MADE TO VICTIMS OF**
2 **NAZI PERSECUTION DISREGARDED IN DE-**
3 **TERMINING ELIGIBILITY FOR AND THE**
4 **AMOUNT OF NEED-BASED BENEFITS AND**
5 **SERVICES.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Payments made to individuals be-
7 cause of their status as victims of Nazi persecution shall
8 be disregarded in determining eligibility for and the
9 amount of benefits or services to be provided under any
10 Federal or federally assisted program which provides bene-
11 fits or services based, in whole or in part, on need.

12 (b) APPLICABILITY.—Subsection (a) shall apply to
13 determinations made on or after the date of the enactment
14 of this Act with respect to payments referred to in sub-
15 section (a) made before, on, or after such date.

16 (c) PROHIBITION AGAINST RECOVERY OF VALUE OF
17 EXCESSIVE BENEFITS OR SERVICES PROVIDED DUE TO
18 FAILURE TO TAKE ACCOUNT OF CERTAIN PAYMENTS
19 MADE TO VICTIMS OF NAZI PERSECUTION.—No officer,
20 agency, or instrumentality of any government may at-
21 tempt to recover the value of excessive benefits or services
22 provided before the date of the enactment of this Act
23 under any program referred to in subsection (a) by reason
24 of any failure to take account of payments referred to in
25 subsection (a).
