## A BILL

To amend section 437c, title 2, United States Code.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3       Section 437c, title 2, United States Code is amended by  
4       striking:

5       **“§ 437c. Federal Election Commission**

6       “(a)(1) There is established a commission to be  
7       known as the Federal Election Commission. The Commis-  
8       sion is composed of the Secretary of the Senate and the  
9       Clerk of the House of Representatives or their designees,  
10      ex officio and without the right to vote, and 6 members  
11      appointed by the President, by and with the advice and  
12      consent of the Senate.”; and inserting in lieu thereof:

1 **“§ 437c. Federal Election Commission**

2       “(a)(1) There is established a commission to be  
3 known as the Federal Election Commission. The Commis-  
4 sion is composed of the Secretary of the Senate, the Sec-  
5 retary for the Minority, to be paid at the same rate and  
6 from the same account the Clerk of the House of Rep-  
7 resentatives and the Minority Clerk of the House of Rep-  
8 resentatives, to be paid the same amount and from the  
9 same account or their designees, ex officio and without  
10 the right to vote, and 6 members appointed by the Presi-  
11 dent, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate.”.
