Relating to the purchase of calendars.

1 *Resolved*, That the Committee on Rules and Adminis-
2 tration is authorized to expend from the contingent fund
3 of the Senate, upon vouchers approved by the chairman
4 of that committee, not to exceed \$76,960 for the purchase
5 of one hundred and four thousand 1994 “We The People”
6 calendars. The calendars shall be distributed as prescribed
7 by the committee.
