## **RESOLUTION**

To amend the Standing Rules of the Senate to provide for  
the germaneness of committee amendments post-cloture.

1        *Resolved*, That rule XXII of the Standing Rules of  
2 the Senate is amended by adding at the end of paragraph  
3 3 of section 2 the following:

4        “In the case of a measure that has been reported by  
5 a committee that contains recommended committee  
6 amendments, such amendments shall be considered ger-  
7 mane.”.
