RESOLUTION

To amend the Standing Rules of the Senate to provide that quorum calls are charged against an individual's time under cloture.

1 *Resolved*, That rule XXII of the Standing Rules of
2 the Senate is amended by striking the “.” after speaks
3 in paragraph 3 of section 2 and inserting in lieu thereof
4 the following: “, with the time consumed by quorum calls
5 being charged to the Senator who requested the call of
6 the quorum.”.
