Mr. MITCHELL submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the
Committee on Rules and Administration

RESOLUTION

To amend the Standing Rules of the Senate to dispense
with the reading of conference reports.

1 *Resolved*, That rule XXVIII of the Standing Rules of
2 the Senate is amended by striking “and shall be deter-
3 mined without debate.” in paragraph 1. and inserting in
4 lieu thereof the following: “notwithstanding a request for
5 the reading of the conference report, and shall be deter-
6 mined without debate.”.
